

Artists double up

TWO talented women artists are sharing an exhibition in Marlborough from until November 8.

Joannah May, at whose Hughenden Yard gallery the exhibition is being held, is well known for her studies of hares.

Just days ago Joannah sold her latest painting *The Hare In The Moon* for an unprecedented \$6,000.

She will be sharing the exhibition with equestrian artist Jenny Arthy from Winterbourne Monkton.

Both artists will be including their most recent

works which in Joannah's case will include a print of *The Hare In The Moon* that she sold to a local buyer a few weeks ago.

Jenny Arthy began to concentrate on equestrian paintings after spending a day at the racecourse with a friend.

One of her most outstanding recent works is based on pictures she saw of horses being led by looters through war-torn Baghdad. The exhibition will be open Monday and Tuesday 10am-noon; and on Thursday, Friday and Saturday 10am-5pm.
